Next, we head towards the outer reaches of the valley and explore the scenic hill of Nagarkot which remains a famous vantage point for tourists. In addition to that, we even drive to the ancient town of Bhaktapur and then to Changunarayan Temple. Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) Kathmandu(1350m)

You are welcomed by our team staff members and then transferred to the booked hotel. After a refreshment break, our representative will briefly explain the program. Overnight at hotel at B/B basis program.

Day 02: Kathmandu Valley full day Sightseeing tour

This is a day for sightseeing world heritage sites in the Kathmandu Valley including, Kathmandu Darbar Square, Swayambhunath Chaitya and Patan durbar square. Overnight at the hotel at same program.B/B

Day 3 : Kathmandu to Nagarkot visiting Bhaktapur and Changunarayan by private car

In the morning after having breakfast, we drive to Bhaktapur for its rich cultural and traditional heritage exploration then move to Changunarayan Temple with a private car. We visit the oldest pagoda style temple which was listed by UNESCO as a world heritage site. It has been constructed in 4th century. This temple is dedicated to Lord Vishnu in his incarnation as Narayan. From there we walk to Telkot which takes about 2 hour. From here, we again drive to nagarkot which takes about half an hour. Nagarkot is usually considered to be the best vantage point for viewing Langtang Range, Ganesh Himal, Gaurisankar, Jugul Himal and other snow capped High Himalaya as well as Sunrise and Sunset View over the Himalayas. In the evening we will enjoy with unobstructed Sunset view over the High Mountains. Overnight at Hotel on B/B basis.

Day 4: Nagarkot to Kathmandu via Pashupati and Baudhanath by private car

In this day, it is best to view the mountains in the early morning because it is more likely to be clear. There is a viewing tower where you get good views of High Himalayan Ranges. We will enjoy with Breathtaking Sunrise View as well as 360° view of the scenery from the Lookout Tower which is an hour walk from the our Hotel. Nagarkot has become famous as one of the best spots to view Mount Everest as well as other snow-topped peaks of the Himalayan range of eastern Nepal. It also offers an excellent view of the Indrawati river valley to the east. Nagarkot also offers a panoramic view of the Kathmandu Valley and is described by visitors as a place whose beauty endures year round. While back to Kathmandu, we visit Pashupatinath temple and Baudhanath stupa. Pashupatinath temple is one of the most famous temples for hindus and most famous hindu temple in Nepal. Temple premise and its structure is a perfect example of pagoda style or Nepali style temple. This place is also very famous for the hindu cremation where tourists can see the extremely different culture.

Baudhanath is in a very close distance to Pashupatinath, it is the largest stupa in Nepal where relics of Kasyapa Buddha is believed to be preserved inside. We will have a dinner in a typical Nepali restaurant. Overnight at Hotel on B/B basis.

Day 5: Final Departure Day

After breakfast depending on your schedule transfer to International Airport for final departure. You have to enter 3 hrs before your flight time.
